Bus Rider Code of Conduct

Safety is the top concern when School Age Children ride the SAS busses. The following rules are the Bus Rider Code of Conduct that all SAS children who ride the busses will abide by. This Code of Conduct will be read on every bus so that each child is aware.

1. Seatbelts will be worn AT ALL TIMES. Seatbelts must be tightened. Playing with the seatbelts (swinging them around, throwing them over the seat) is not allowed.
2. The SAS Bully Policy is in effect on the bus.
3. Normal conversation voices will be used.
4. Pencils, pens or anything with a point must stay in backpacks while on the bus.
5. All personal toys, music players belong at home.
6. While loading and unloading the bus, children will wait for staff to give directions. Children must WALK to and from the bus.
7. Parents will inform the SAS site if their child will not be on the bus.

Thank you all for following this Bus Code of Conduct. Safety is the top concern. Deviations from this Code of Conduct could result in suspension from the bus.
