Documentation required from **sponsors of stepchildren:**

1. Housing letter that shows child is authorized to reside in household.
2. Legal documents showing that the spouse has legal primary custody of the child (this may be a separate custody agreement or part of a divorce decree-we only need to see information relating to custody)
3. If the spouse's last name is different from the child's, birth certificate (this could occur if spouse has remarried more than once)
4. In loco parentis affidavit executed by sponsor and notarized.

Health Requirements for registration

1. School physical completed within the past 6 months to a year or proof of an appointment for a physical.
2. Each student must have his/her own social security number.

Immunization Requirements are provided after school zoning.

Age eligibility

Pre-Kindergarten eligibility: 4 years old by the 1st of October
 Kindergarten eligibility: 5 years old by the 1st of October

[Immunization Requirements](#)

Dear Parents,

IAW Department of Defense Education Activity DoDEA guidelines and mandates, as well as to comply with Kentucky law, starting in 2004-05 school year, there will be a policy change in how Ft. Campbell Schools handle student immunizations against communicable diseases. As you know all students **must have a Kentucky Immunization Certificate** showing that all their immunizations are up to date and a physical when they are new to our schools. All sixth graders must also have a physical and their shot record will be reviewed as well. The following immunizations are required by DoDEA:

- **Hepatitis B (Hep B)**
- **Diphtheria and tetanus toxoids and pertussis vaccine [acellular (DyaP) is preferred over whole cell (DPT) for all doses in the series]**
- **Haemophilis influenzae Type B (Hib)**
- **Poliovirus [combination of injectable (IPV) and oral (OPV) is preferred]**
- **Measles-mumps-rubella (MMR)**
- **Varicella (Var) (Chicken pox)**

(TB tests are no longer required.)

Students will no longer be allowed to attend classes without an up-to-date immunization record and/or evidence of a doctor's appointment to complete a physical if required. This also pertains to students who need an additional immunization during the course of the school year. As you know immunizations are recurrent events. Our school nurses are very diligent in tracking individual student immunization deadlines over the course of a year. It is therefore very important that you take the time and insure that your student's immunizations are always up to date.

Please know that the safety of all students is the driving force behind any policy change.
