

## MEMORANDUM FOR CABC/HUNTING AND FISHING UNIT

SUBJECT: Early migratory bird seasons

1. Migratory bird hunting seasons will be allowed on the installation using the seasons published by Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) for portions of the Post in Tennessee and Kentucky Division of Fish and Wildlife Resources for Kentucky portions of the Post.
2. The following ponds will be available for waterfowl hunting under the current co-use agreement. Due to the ongoing drought, many of these ponds are dry at this time.

3. Waterfowl hunting will also be allowed on Lake Kyle on Monday, Thursday and Saturdays. No permanent blinds are available, however hunters are allowed to use temporary blinds but must remove them at the end of each hunt.
4. Dove hunting will be allowed from the following locations under the current co-use agreement.

5. Other fields may be added as agriculture fields or food plots are harvested.
6. Migratory bird hunting is also allowed in training areas open to small game unless closed by the installation biologist.
