### **Operation Rising Star Comes to Fort Campbell MWR**

Operation Rising Star is coming to Fort Campbell! Formally known as Military Idol, Operation Rising Star is a talent competition much like American Idol, except it is only open to Active Duty, National Guard or Reservists from any branch of Service and Family Members 18 years and older with a valid Military ID. The competition now allows the use of musical instruments and a Spirit Award for Unit and Family Readiness Groups (FRG).

Fort Campbell's winners will be determined after several entertaining and intense rounds of competition. Over a span of six weeks, judges and audience will eliminate competitors weekly to narrow down the selection for semi finals and the finals.

During auditions, contestants will perform a cappella, (without musical accompaniment or props), for a panel of three judges. Auditions for Operation Rising Star will be held at the Sportsman's Lodge on August 6, 7 and 8 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

In subsequent rounds, contestants will perform for judges and an audience. The audience's votes will make up 50 percent of the determination as to who will be selected Fort Campbell's winner. The dates of competition are Thursdays, August 14, 21, 28 and September 4, with semifinals and finals on Fridays, September 12 and September 19. All dates will be held at Sportsman's Lodge from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m.

Fort Campbell's winner will receive \$500 in cash and an opportunity to advance to the televised Army-wide finals. The most supportive Unit or FRG at Fort Campbell will win a \$300 cash prize, to be added to their Unit Fund. The winner of the Army-wide competition will be awarded an all-expense-paid trip for the winner and a guest for three days to Los Angeles, California to create a demo CD. This includes vocal coaching, professional arrangement, sound engineering and tickets to a late night talk show. The second place winner of the Army-wide competition will be awarded a \$1000 cash prize and the third place winner will be win \$500 cash.
